Former Intel vet takes CTO post at AMD

Longtime **Intel** Corp. engineer Donald Newell is taking over as chief technology officer of the server division at rival **Advanced Micro Devices**. Newell left Intel (NASDAQ: INTC) in March and three months later took a position with AMD (NYSE: AMD) to lead its server roadmap and platform design programs.

Newell spent 16 years at Intel. Most recently he was senior principal engineer and director at Intel Labs in Hillsboro, where he led development of system on a chip and server platform architecture innovations for areas including cloud computer and hand-held devices. He has filed more than 20 patents.

In his newest position, Newell will lead multiple worldwide teams and work alongside AMD design and development teams to bring new products to market.
