



Executive Search Demand Up 30% January through April

Renewable Energy, Wireless Industries Driving Demand*

Cleveland, OH – May 26, 2009 – Search demand is up 30% comparing January through April 2009, reports leading retained executive search firm, ON Search Partners. The firm reports that the sectors driving the demand are renewable energy and wireless. The demand for renewable energy has risen 52% from January through April, and wireless demand is up 46% through the same period.

According to Shawn Oglesbee, Managing Partner of ON Search, “This is a direct result of steady, continuing financing for the wireless sector. In addition, renewable energy is continuing to see valuations rise up to 50 percent on private offerings despite the downturn for publicly traded companies. Companies and the financial markets are gearing up for continued high consumer demand for wireless, and increased government stimulus funding of green technologies.”

Mr. Oglesbee says the positions in highest demand are CEO and Executive Vice President of Sales for the wireless industries. “There is a strong emphasis on sales people that can capitalize on continued strong consumer demand in Asia, and in particular, Korea and China. Plus, top executives must know how to leverage global manufacturing.”

In the renewable energy sector, the firm reports high demand for executives in fuel cell, LED lighting and solar sectors. “Key high demand positions in this sector are CFOs and CEOs. And, today, the top sales driver needs to be the CEO,” he concluded.
